Please note: It is the decision of the LRYC Executive that participants (or Instructors) are not allowed stay overnight on board boats without the supervision of a parent or guardian.

A Berthing Plan will be drawn up before the beginning of the JSC and copies will be posted on the Clubhouse window & on the poles on the jetties. The allocated berthing positions are not protected for the duration of the JSC in the event of leaving same. The Club rules do not permit boats to be left unoccupied overnight, on the South Jetty, North Bight or inside the floating jetty for the duration of the JSC.

***Electricity:** Boats/caravans etc may use plug-in cables, but only after application and payment of the prescribed electricity charge (and Berthing charge), which for the 2017 season has been set at €15 per week (not including August Regatta). An adhesive receipt will be issued, which must be attached to the cable. For safety reasons power supplies may not be divided by multiple adapters or by any other means; no cable may be used on more than one vessel. The power supply is limited to 6 amps. NON-COMPLIANCE with electricity rules will lead to termination of supply.

Please note that children staying on boats while participating in the JSC, are the responsibility of parents/guardians. JSC supervision will cease at 4.30pm each day.

Rules:

1. Fevas are available for the LRYC Junior Sailing Course (JSC) to sailors who have attained Improving Skills on the ISA Small Boat Sailing Scheme.
2. The rental fee shall be decided by the Executive from time to time and shall include a sum for insurance, wear and tear.
3. A refundable deposit shall be payable.
4. The hirer and his or her parent/guardian shall be responsible for the stowage and safe return of the Feva and shall be liable for any loss or damage incurred while in his or her care and not covered by the LRYC Insurance Policy. All Feva parts are marked, where possible, with the boat number. As with 'owned boats', it is recommended that bungs, ties, sheets shackles etc should be brought home each evening for safe keeping. The hirer must replace any boat parts which go missing. **Parents need to impress on the children the importance of respecting other peoples' property and of taking responsibility for their own equipment.**
5. Fevas will be issued to hirers by John McGonigle at 6pm on the Sunday before the rental period begins, i.e. Sunday July 5th, or by arrangement. Hirers must be accompanied by their parent or guardian and will be required to inspect the boat and to sign a form indicating that they will be responsible for the proper care and maintenance of the boat while it is in their care. Boats will be returned by the hirer, together with his or her parent or guardian, to John McGonigle on the Friday evening at the end of their rental period when they will be inspected and the deposit returned, where appropriate.
6. All Feva users must wear adequate personal buoyancy at all times.
7. Rescue personnel on duty must be informed when the Feva is being taken out and of the helmsman and crew of each boat. Boat crews must obey the instructions of the rescue personnel.
8. The boat may not be lent or re-hired to others by the hirer.
9. All damage must be reported immediately to John McGonigle or other nominated person.
10. It is not permissible to remove the boats from the club sailing areas.
11. The final decision on weather conditions and sailing experience shall reside with the Senior Instructor or his nominee.
12. Training sails only to be used, except when participating in a racing event by prior agreement with John McGonigle.
13. Please note that the Fevas may be required for one day during the JSC as the Fevas will be sailed by Go Racing 1 group in the annual team racing event between LRYC and LDYC.

Please note that where a Feva is being shared with another Sailing Course participant, one person is to assume the responsibility of 'hirer' and consequently there should only be one application form for each Feva, accompanied by one cheque for the rental period and one cheque of €250 for the deposit.

NOTE: It is important to pay the Feva deposit with a separate cheque of €250. When this cheque is received it is not cashed but held until the hired boat is returned, undamaged. The €250 cheque for the deposit is then torn up.

Rules:

1. Picos are available for the Junior Sailing Course to sailors doing SBSS Start Sailing and Basic Skills and Cara na Mara Dolphins and Orcas.
2. The rental fee shall be decided by the Executive from time to time and shall include a sum for insurance, wear and tear.
3. A refundable deposit shall be payable.
4. The hirer and his or her parent/guardian shall be responsible for the stowage and safe return of the Pico and shall be liable for any loss or damage incurred while in his or her care and not covered by the LRYC Insurance Policy. All Pico parts are marked, where possible, with the boat number. As with 'owned boats', it is recommended that bungs, ties, sheets shackles etc should be brought home each evening for safe keeping. The hirer must replace any boat parts which go missing. Parents need to impress on the children the importance of respecting other peoples' property and of taking responsibility for their own equipment.
5. Picos will be issued to hirers by John McGonigle at 6pm on the Sunday before the rental period begins. Hirers must be accompanied by their parent or guardian and will be required to inspect the boat and to sign a form indicating that they will be responsible for the proper care and maintenance of the boat while it is in their care. Boats will be returned by the hirer, together with his or her parent or guardian, to John McGonigle on the Friday evening at the end of their rental period when they will be inspected and the deposit returned, where appropriate.
6. All Picos users must wear adequate personal buoyancy at all times.
7. Rescue personnel on duty must be informed when the Pico is being taken out and of the helmsman and crew of each boat. Boat crews must obey the instructions of the rescue personnel.
8. The boat may not be lent or re-hired to others by the hirer.
9. All damage must be reported immediately to John McGonigle or other nominated person.
10. It is not permissible to remove the boats from the club sailing areas.
11. The final decision on weather conditions and sailing experience shall reside with the Senior Instructor or his nominee.

Please note that where a Pico is being shared with another Sailing Course participant, one person is to assume the responsibility of 'hirer' and consequently there should only be one application form for each Pico accompanied by one cheque for the rental period and one cheque of refundable €100 for the deposit.

NOTE: It is important to pay the Pico deposit with a separate cheque for €100. When this cheque is received it is not cashed but held until the hired boat is returned, undamaged. The €100 deposit cheque is then torn up.
