NOTES: MOORING / CAMPING / BEACH MASTERS / TOILETS

Please obey instructions of Beach Masters.

Berths/Camping/Caravanning facilities are available only to Regatta participants and should be booked and paid for at an early date, as facilities are limited. Yachts entered in the Regatta Cruiser Class may berth overnight free of charge. Cruisers/Houseboat/Barge berths will be posted on the Club notice board and website.

TOILET/SHOWER FACILITIES: Occupants of boats without holding tanks should use the Club's toilet and shower facilities ashore.

ELECTRICITY SUPPLY: Electricity supply is limited to six amps to provide supply for a fridge and battery charger. The use of heavy duty items like Immersions, Microwaves, Kettles, Hairdryers, etc. are all prohibited. These trip the system and as a result all berths will have no power.

ENGINE RUNNING: Engines should not be used for battery charging etc.
